Categories	Notes	Amount
Adult Membership	Squad members making full use of SBC equipment. Members may row and race in all boats and conditions subject to Captain's approval.	£561
Coxing / Coaching	Category for those actively involved in coxing / coaching. May not row in club boats nor store private boats. To qualify for this category, you must be currently active at Staines Boat Club and is at the discretion of the committee. Coaching members who are active will have their coaching membership refunded at the discretion of the committee. Those who wish to row as well need to take out rowing membership.	£68
Supporter	Category for those not actively involved in the sport. May be Remenham Club members and be club officers. May not row in club boats nor store private boats.	£74
Casual Rowing	Not available for new members. Members who joined after 2012, are not Junior/Student, and row, should be Adult members. Previously called Leisure, this category is for existing members who are not squad members, do not compete and row on an occasional basis. Casual members will pay an additional £20 in membership fees for each race they compete in for SBC. Full Adult members will have priority on equipment at peak times.	£555
Junior/Student/under 25	In full-time education. All adult members under 25 qualify for this category.	£449
Paddle sports/Gym only	Members of the paddle sport section of SBC. Involves the use of personal O1 Kayaks, OC1/VAR Canoes and Standup Paddleboards. Paddle Sport/Gym only members cannot row. They can make use of club house equipment (weights/Ergos). Rowing squads take priority over club house equipment and main room at peak times.	£210
Student term time only	In full-time education and attending local college but live away during vacations.	£297
Student Vacations Only	Active rowing category for students who can only row during holidays.	£203

Temporary	Over 18s who use the club's bar & other facilities for a limited period of time. Please contact Membership Secretary for details.	POA
